

## Terms and Conditions for START:IP

### For Technology Providers

1. **START:IP** is a matchmaking service for the commercialization of technologies from academic or industrial research and development.
2. **START:IP** is organized by INiTS Universitäres Gründerservice Wien GmbH (hereinafter referred to as "**organizer**").
3. **Technology providers** are universities, research institutions or companies that own wholly or partly the intellectual property rights of the technologies offered.
4. **Technology seekers** are founders, investors, and company representatives in search of technologies as a basis for new products or services.
5. **START:IP** starts on 1 August 2020 and ends on 31 January 2021.
6. The Matching event is scheduled on 27 January 2021. Depending on the COVID 19 situation the **organizer** reserves the right to arrange the Matching event virtually in one day or as a series of shorter, multi-day online events. A detailed plan will be communicated by 1 December 2020 the latest.
7. All information exchanged during **START:IP** between the **technology provider** and the **organizer** will be considered non-confidential
8. In case confidential information must be shared between **technology provider** and **technology seeker**, a separate non-disclosure agreement will be concluded between the parties.
9. The **technology provider** will provide the **organizer** with the necessary information on the individual technologies free of charge.
10. The regular registration fee per technology amounts to EUR 1.500 (excl. VAT).
11. For registrations until 31 July 2020 the latest there is a **super early bird registration fee** per technology of **EUR 1.050** (excl. VAT). For registrations in the period between 1 August 2020 and 30 September 2020 the **early bird registration fee** amounts to **EUR 1.200** per technology (excl. VAT).
12. In order to take advantage of these special prices, **technology providers** have to place a purchase order for at least one technology in time. In the purchase order all relevant invoice data (bill-to address, purchase order number, VAT number, i.e) have to be stated. The invoicing by the **organizer** will be done immediately after receipt of the purchase order.

13. If multiple technologies are registered, the following discounts on the regular registration fee apply:

2 <sup>nd</sup> technology	-10
3 <sup>rd</sup> technology	-20
4 <sup>th</sup> technology	-30
5 <sup>th</sup> and subsequent technologies	-40

14. Only after the registration fee for a specific technology has been paid in full, the **technology provider** is entitled to receive the following services:

- Publication of the technology on the **START:IP** website,
- Profiling of the **technology seekers** to be invited to the Matching event,
- Introduction to interested technology seekers (if applicable)
- 1-hour dry run with individual feedback prior to the Matching event (via MS Teams or Zoom),
- 5 Tickets for the Matching event for the **technology provider's** entire research team as well as the technology transfer manager(s),
- Time slot for a ten (10) minute presentation per technology as well as a booth at the venue (comparable in size and exposure with other technology providers),
- Video recording of the presentation at the Matching event.

15. Any and all disputes, controversies and conflicts between the **organizer** and the **technology provider** arising during the duration of **START:IP** will be, so far as is possible, settled amicably between the Parties within fifteen (15) days after written notice of such dispute, controversy or conflict has been given by one Party to the other Party. In case an amicable solution is not found within the said period, the Austrian courts shall have exclusive jurisdiction and Austrian law shall apply.

16. Invoices raised by the **organizer** are due thirty (30) days after invoice date.
